# Cordillera Day Camp Policies and Procedures

*In order for camp to run safely and efficiently, we ask that parents read and become familiar with the policies and procedures listed below.*

- Camp Information:** Days: Monday – Friday  
Dates: June 1 – August 28  
Ages: 5 – 12  
Enrollment: 35 campers/day
- Drop-off/pick-up at the Trailhead Facility**  
3000 Fenno Drive, Cordillera  
Drop-off: 9:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.  
Pick-up: 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- What to bring:** Clearly labeled backpack, cold lunch, two snacks, water bottle, hat, jacket or sweatshirt, comfortable shoes for playing outside, swimsuit, towel, swim goggles, sunglasses, sunscreen, and rain gear. Please leave electronic devices at home.
- Meals & Snacks:** Children are responsible for bringing two snacks and a lunch to camp each day. A microwave is available on the premises for camp staff use only. If a child brings a “heat-up” to camp, a staff person will ensure that it gets warmed up for the child. If a child forgets his/her lunch, parents will be called to bring one to camp before 11:00 a.m. **NOTE: Out of respect for our participants with allergies, Cordillera Day Camp and the Trailhead are “nut free” facilities. Please keep this in mind when packing your child’s lunch.**
- CDC offers a morning and afternoon snack each day, accompanied by drinking water. These snacks usually include goldfish crackers, graham crackers or some kind of snack mix. Nuts are never offered for snack but some of the snacks are produced in facilities that also use nuts for other purposes. If a child has allergies, it is the parent’s responsibility to notify camp staff via the health form and to provide appropriate snacks for their child.
- Registration:** Children ages 5-12 will be admitted to Cordillera Day Camp on a first-come, first served basis. Drop-ins are not permitted and children must be registered by 5 p.m. the day prior to the day they wish to attend camp. Once a child’s registration forms are complete and CDC has received copies of the Camp health form, immunization records and a birth certificate, a parent may call camp to make reservations for future dates. Without these forms on file children will not be permitted to attend camp.
- Cancellations:** Payment is non-refundable unless reservations are cancelled 48-hours in advance. All cancellations will be subject to a \$2 processing fee.
- Late Drop-Off:** Daily drop-off takes place from 9:00 – 9:30 a.m. Drop-off after 9:30 a.m. is not permitted without the Camp Director’s consent. If a child arrives and his/her group has already left the premises for a field trip or other activity, the late arrival will have to leave for the day unless an alternate group or activity can be established. The Camp Director or head counselor will ensure that the late child is placed in an appropriate group.
- Late Pick-Up:** Pick up takes place daily from 4:00 – 5:00 p.m., unless otherwise posted. If a parent shows up late to pick-up a child, he/she is required to pay the camp staff present \$5 for every five minutes past the final pick-up time. Payment is due immediately and parents are warned that continued late pick-up will result in their child not being permitted to attend camp.
- If a parent doesn’t show up at all, repeated phone calls are made to the phone numbers on file and finally the person listed on that child’s file for emergency contact is called. At no time will a child be left at camp alone. If a parent fails to show up, the Camp Director will remain with the child until a parent or the emergency contact arrives to pick up the child. If no contact can be made whatsoever, the Department of Social Services will be called to pick up the child.
- Discipline Policy:** The staff at Cordillera Day Camp is instructed to discipline participants in the following manner: The unruly child is taken aside and told quietly what he/she is doing wrong and what can be done to remedy the problem. Usually that camper is assigned to an alternate activity or group of children in order to prevent the negative incident from reoccurring. If the behavior continues, the child is taken into the Camp Director’s office to sit in a chair and explain to the Director what he/she did wrong and why they did it. They must remain, seated quietly, for five minutes or until the Director gives them permission to return to their activities. The Director will notify the camp counselor that the child is returning to group.
- If the inappropriate behavior occurs again that day, the child is brought into the Camp Director’s office and instructed to call his/her parents to come pick-up him/her up for the day. If parents are called repeatedly, the child will no longer be welcome at camp.
- Sick Policy:** It is Cordillera Day Camp’s policy to notify parents immediately in case of a sickness, injury or accident concerning their child. All parents are required to leave the number at which they can be reached each day that their child attends camp. CDC staff will continue to call all numbers listed until a parent is reached.
- In case of illness, the child is kept in the playroom downstairs away from other campers until a parent can come pick him/her up from camp. Parents are required to pick sick children up immediately. In case of a minor injury, parents will be called and it will be determined if a child is well enough to remain at camp. The final decision on whether a child may stay at camp is based on the Camp Director’s best judgment. In case of serious injury in which a child must be transported to a hospital or doctor’s office, the parents will be notified immediately as to the details of the injury and at what medical facility they can find their child. It is for this reason that all medical records must be on hand and up-to-date before a child may attend camp.
- Medication:** CDC staff is not permitted to administer medication to children without a prescription and written directions from a doctor or health care provider, in addition to a signed parental authorization. Only staff persons who are certified in medication administration are permitted to give campers their prescriptions each day.
- Emergency procedures:** Upon registering a child, parents are asked to provide detailed information concerning the health of the child, which is kept confidential and on site. In case of an illness or injury, the parents and/or the emergency contact will be notified immediately. In case of a serious medical emergency, an ambulance will be called to take the child to the nearest hospital for treatment. Parents are responsible for payment of all medical treatments.
- Camp Transportation:** It is often necessary to transport children from camp to golf and tennis clinics or for field trips. Children are transported by approved counselors, the Director of Recreation or the Camp Director. Cordillera Club Properties sends out a list of approved drivers based on current driving records. Only CCP approved drivers over 21 years of age are permitted to transport campers. One staff person will be on board for every five children that are being transported.
- In order for a child to attend a clinic or field trip, a signed travel waiver must be on hand in the Camp Director’s office. If a child still meets the state requirements for a car seat or booster seat, that seat must be left for camp staff to install in a camp van. It is recommended that parents stay and install the seat themselves prior to a field trip or clinic.

All campers must wear a seatbelt at all times while riding in camp vehicles. All seatbelts are checked by camp staff before a camp vehicle leaves the property. If a child unbuckles his/her seatbelt while the vehicle is moving, that vehicle will immediately pull over until the seatbelt is buckled. If a child continues to unbuckle or will not buckle up at all, parents will be called to pick up that child immediately and he/she will no longer be permitted to attend field trips or clinics. Children are not permitted in the front passenger seat at any time.

**Field Trips:** Approximately two times each month campers have the opportunity to leave the Trailhead facility to attend field trips. If an outside vendor is going to be used (i.e. theme park, climbing wall, rafting company, etc.) a signed waiver from that vendor must be on hand for each child. The CDC travel waiver from the original registration form must also be on file.

A roster for the field trip is kept by the CDC staff to ensure that the proper number of children are in the van(s) at all times. These rosters include health information, parents' phone numbers, and healthcare provider information.

Children are required to bring a cold, sack lunch on these excursions and drinking water and sunscreen are transported with the vehicle for all children. The child:counselor ratio for field trips is approximately 7:1.

**Television or Videos:** On rare occasion, campers are given the opportunity to view a video or DVD at camp. Parents must sign a waiver permitting campers to view movies rated G or PG. If no waiver is on file and parents cannot be reached, children will be given an alternate activity in which to participate during the movie.

Television is not viewed during Cordillera Day Camp at any time. We also request that all video game players, CD, DVD & MP3 players are left at home or locked up in the camp safe for the day.

**Authorized Pick-Up:** Upon registration, Cordillera Day Camp requires parents to leave a list of people authorized to pick up their child from camp. If an unauthorized person attempts to pick-up a child at any time, they will be denied permission and parents will be called immediately. If the unauthorized visitor refuses to leave the premises, Cordillera Public Safety will be called to escort the visitor off the property.

**Locating a Lost Child:** Each staff person is assigned a small number of children for which he/she is responsible at different times during the day. It is that counselor's responsibility to do head counts on a regular basis and to follow up with any campers who may have stepped into the restroom or moved on to another activity with the permission of his/her counselor. Each counselor who leaves the building carries a walkie talkie and is in direct contact with other counselors and the Camp Director at all times.

If a child goes missing while at camp or on a field trip, the remaining campers are collected into one small room or area. The Camp Director or head counselor stays with that group of children while the other counselors perform a search. If this happens while on a field trip, the staff at the location being visited is informed immediately and a facility-wide search is conducted. If necessary, the local authorities will be brought in to help conduct the search. If the camper is lost at camp, a search of the pool area, playground and local trails will be conducted. If necessary, Cordillera Public Safety will be notified to help with the search. The child's parent(s) will also be called at this point and the local authorities will be brought in to assist.

**Personal Belongings:** Children are assigned a "cubby" each day in order to store their backpacks, etc. Money and other valuables are not recommended at camp. If a child must bring valuables to camp, it is recommended that they be turned into the Camp Director to be stored in the camp safe. The CDC is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

**Weather Conditions:** In case of inclement weather, appropriate indoor games will be arranged by the CDC staff. Inclement weather includes but is not limited to excessively hot or cold weather, lightening strikes and rain showers. If campers are in the pool during lightening storms, the pool staff will remove the campers immediately and have them sit in a warm, dry place until the storms have passed (at least 30 minutes after the last strike). If a storm looks to last more than 30 minutes, children will get dressed and participate in indoor games for the duration of the swim session.

**Camp Visitors:** Cordillera Day Camp requests that parents/guests/friends refrain from visiting camp between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5 p.m. However, if a visit is requested camp staff will ensure that the child is available for a visit based upon a pre-determined timeframe. Visitors must have written permission from a parent (verbal notification is also appreciated) before coming to camp. Drop-in visitors will not be turned away if they have proper consent.

**Children with Disabilities:** Cordillera Day Camp is in compliance with Titles I through V of the Americans with Disabilities Act. CDC will make every effort to accommodate a disabled child's needs and to integrate the child with his/her peers who do not have disabilities.

**Reporting Child Abuse:** All employees of CDC are required to sign a statement clearly defining child abuse and neglect pursuant to state law and outlining the staff member's personal responsibility to report all incidents of child abuse or neglect according to state law.

If a staff person at Cordillera Day Camp suspects some form of child abuse, a complaint will be filed with the licensing authority within 24-hours of the incident or discovery of the incident. If an employee of CDC is suspected of some form of abuse, the incident will be reported within 24 hours and the employee will go on unpaid leave until a formal investigation can be conducted. At all times, the proper local authorities, including the county social services department and the police department, will be notified immediately.

**Withdrawal of Services:** If, at any time, Cordillera Day Camp must suspend day camp services, parents will be notified immediately via e-mail, telephone and/or US Mail. Notification will occur in the manner that best suits the situation and depends upon the timeframe for the closure.
